Clover Brings Free Tax Prep Services, Resources & Family Fun on Super Tax Day

Clover Super Tax Day and Family Resources Fair will offer free tax services and family fun on Clover's main campus courtyard and Gayle and Tom Benson Community Center on Saturday, March 11th, 9AM to 3PM, at 1600 Constance St., New Orleans, 70130. Entrance will be the rear side of the building at Annunciation & Richard cross streets.

Super Tax Day is initiative of the agency's VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) tax preparers which offers free tax preparation services for households earning up to \$60,000 annually. Interpreters will be onsite to translate for Hispanic families.

Other family resources and activities at Clover will include:

- Free health screenings including blood pressure checks and other wellness resources
- Health navigators to assist families with Louisiana Medicaid coverage update concerns
- Free energy efficient light bulbs
- Southeast Louisiana Legal Services representatives onsite to help families with matters of civil law issues
- WIC (Jefferson Parish) Healthy Start & Second Harvest Food Bank and more
- Free food, DJ and play area for the kids!

Individuals coming to file taxes should bring the following for their appointment:

- Photo ID for individual and spouse
- Social Security Cards (or copies) for individual, spouse, and dependents you are claiming
- An individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) assignment letter may be substituted for you, your spouse and your dependents if you do not have a Social Security card
- Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents
- A copy of last year's federal and state tax returns or copies of income transcripts from the IRS and state
- Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099-INT, 1099-DIV)
- Bank routing and account numbers for direct deposit

Early preparers can also walk to the start of the Irish Italian Parade starting at 1PM on the corner of Magazine and Felicity to continue the celebration!
